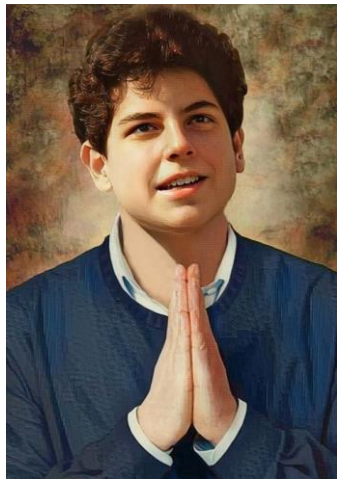

✠ **Carlo Acutis** was born in London on 3rd May 1991 and was Baptised fifteen days later; the Catechism teaches us that the sanctifying grace received in this sacrament perfects the soul to enable it to act in love and finally to live with God (# 2000). The whole Acutis family returned home to Milan in September 1991. Carlo's parents had lapsed from the Faith and rarely fulfilled the obligation to participate in the Sunday Mass. His mother admits that: "I was not the ideal

model of a Catholic mother". Carlo was a normal child, but his faith was extraordinary; at the age of only five he consecrated himself to Our Lady of Pompeii. Like any young person, Carlo had his weaknesses and temptations; he was a joker who enjoyed making his classmates and teachers laugh! His school reports show he could be disruptive; yet, on realising this, he made every effort to change. Carlo had a passion for playing video games, including on his PlayStation; yet, he limited himself to doing so for only one hour each week as a form of spiritual penance and discipline. He liked sports, loved animals, enjoyed walks in the Umbrian countryside, played the saxophone and had a sweet tooth! Carlo was declared a Blessed in October 2020 and is likely to be decreed a Saint in 2025. **Blessed Carlo Acutis: Pray for us!**

St Thomas: Pray for us!

St Thomas of Canterbury Prayer Slips will be attached to the newsletter next weekend and on the back of which you can write your own intention, e.g. healing for Angela, for James, etc. The slip is then sealed in the envelope provided and is brought to Mass on 6th/7th July where it is posted in the petitions box before the relic and icon of St Thomas Becket; petition slips returned to SJO will be brought to OLW. The petitions slips will not be read but Holy Mass will be offered for all the intentions on 8th July.

St Thomas Becket Prayer Cards will be distributed before Mass on 6th/7th July and will form part of the Intercessions.



As July is dedicated to the Precious Blood of Jesus, an image of **The Adoration of the Mystic Lamb** will be temporarily added to OLW and at which a sponsored seven-day

candle will burn each day in prayer. In preparation for the feast of Passover the Jewish people would select a spotless lamb from among the yearlings, wash and anoint it and keep it separate for three days before it was sacrificed; during this time, it was called: the Lamb of God. Thus, when St John the Baptist cried out upon seeing Jesus, "Behold! There is the Lamb of God!" (John 1:29) all would have known that Jesus was the Messiah, the true Sacrificial Lamb, who would take away the sins of the world. As we read in Scripture: "Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain..." Apocalypse 5:12. **Precious Blood of Christ, poured out on the Holy Cross: Save us!**

All Readers and Extra-Ordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, and those interested in fulfilling either role,

are encouraged to attend one of the following gatherings:
